Entry Requirements:

Students are expected to meet the following requirements for entry into the programme:

- Must be a minimum of 18 years of age
- Holder of current EMT certification
- Minimum of five (5) CSEC passes (Grades I-III) or equivalent academic qualifications.
- Paramedic Pre-Assessment exam
- Online learning assessment
- Successful completion of EMT psychomotor (skills) assessment
- Successful completion of ETITT Pre-course in Anatomy and Physiology with a grade of 70% or better
- EMT experience an asset (ambulance or other healthcare setting)
- Current professional rescuer CPR/AED certification (AHA or equivalent)
- Current Immunization (Hepatitis B, Tetanus, TB screening, MMR)
- Current police certificate of good character
